Can lay Catholics preside at civil weddings?



My grandson bought a license on the Internet so he could officiate his best friend's wedding. The bride and groom aren't Catholic, but my grandson is, and I think he has committed a sin. Am I right?

Concerned Grandma

Dear Grandma,

If he got a certificate of ordination, even one from the Internet, your grandson presented himself as a minister of another church. For a Catholic, that is a serious sin.

On the other hand, if he bought a license to perform civil marriages, he committed no sin as long as the couple were eligible for civil marriage in the state they were married in. Catholic judges officiate civil marriages all the

time, and they even sanction divorce. These marriages, like the one your grandson officiated, are civil events with no canonical (sacramental) standing.

If your grandson bought a certificate of ordination, he shouldn't preside at any more weddings. He should go to reconciliation as soon as possible to talk about his participation as a minister in his friend's wedding.

If he wants to continue to preside at civil weddings, he must get a license that doesn't call him a "minister" of any church.

The Catholic Church takes all weddings—civil or sacramental—seriously. Even if the weddings your grandson officiates are "only" civil, he and the couple must take them as seriously as the Church does.
