

### First Reading: Genesis 18:20-32

Abraham pleads with the Lord, who planned to destroy Sodom and Gomorrah because of the evil and sin in those cities. Abraham asks him if he would spare the city if fifty, forty, thirty, twenty or even only ten innocent people were found there. God says that he would spare the cities even for the sake of only ten.

## SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he had finished, one of the disciples said to him, 'Lord, teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples.' He said to them, 'When you pray say:...Our Father...'"

How frequently we spy Jesus alone, in a deserted place praying, in communion with His Father. The disciple asked that He teach them, already familiar with the call of John to repentance. Jesus offered what He also teaches us, a prayer of praise, of gratitude, of repentance and petition. This formula we report constantly.

There are prayers too, which go beyond words, known as mental prayer, contemplation, or a very common prayer practice taken from the scripture where a biblical passage becomes the source of meditation. Perhaps the easiest way to pray as a disciple is to remember, our prayer is our intimate conversation with the closest friend I have. I speak; I listen!


## **Gospel Today**

## Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time / Luke 11:1-13

Today's gospel introduces the Our Father, also known as the Lord's (24d) Prayer (5d). We learn further (32d) teachings (19d) about prayer, including how to pray (21a) with your (12a) heart (39a) and mind open (10a), and with persistence (40a). Jesus says to ask (37a), seek (29a) and knock (30d) to receive answers to prayer and forgiveness of sin (31d).


